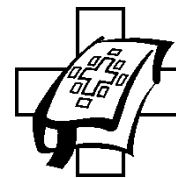




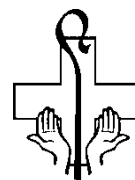

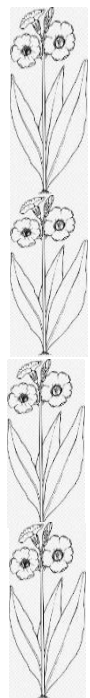
BOOK STUDY: The group is reading “The Saints of Whistle Grove” by Katie Schuermann. They will meet May 22nd at Elaine Becker’s home.
